

# YOUNG PLAYWRIGHTS PROGRAM

#### PROGRAM INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Canberra Youth Theatre is excited to continue the Young Playwright Program in 2022.

Canberra Youth Theatre's *Young Playwright Program* is a training and professional development program for emerging writers aged 16 to 25 years.

Mentored by Mary Rachel Brown and industry professionals, the *Young Playwright Program* will explore individual and collaborative writing processes, and equip participants with the skills to develop their own work. This program is for emerging writers eager to develop creative skills, discover their artistic practice, and gain the tools to build a sustainable career in the arts. Artists will work individually and collaboratively to write and develop short monologues and duologues for young artists.

Over 5 months, members of the *Young Playwright Program* will participate in four strands of artistic development: Writing, Dramaturgy, Creative Development, and Industry Knowledge.

- Writing. Members of the program will train with professional artists, to develop their writing skills, both as individuals, and collaboratively with other members of the program.
- Dramaturgy. Members of the program will receive a one on one session with a professional writer to discuss the piece they have been writing, and receive dramaturgical feedback.
- Creative development. Members of the program will work with actors to hear their works read, and learn how to talk to actors and ask questions in a creative development environment.
- Industry knowledge. Members of the program will be invited to participate in masterclasses delivered by industry professionals on a range of topics, to demystify the practical questions of establishing a career in the arts.

The Young Playwright Program is embedded in the life of Canberra Youth Theatre. Company members will have the opportunity to trial and present work at *Scratch* nights,



attend productions produced by Canberra Youth Theatre, and cross-collaborate with members of the *Emerge Company* and Resident Artists.

The *Young Playwright Program* provides pathways to drama school, future creative developments, and working within the arts industry.

### WHO CAN GET INVOLVED?

Young Playwright Program is open to emerging writers aged 16 - 25 to participate in training and creative development, build creative networks and explore artistic practice.

We encourage submissions from:

- Early Career artists
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists
- Culturally and Linguistically Diverse artists
- Artists who identify as LGBTQIA+
- Artists living with disability

## WHAT DOES THE YOUNG PLAYWRIGHT PROGRAM COST?

Thanks to the generous support of our sponsors and donors, Canberra Youth Theatre is able to offer the Young Playwright Program as a subsidised program to support early career artists in the Canberra region. (The value of this program is \$900 per person.)

We offer a variety of payment options for Young Playwright Program:

- Single payment \$680 (due by Saturday 7 May) or
- Two payments: \$350 per payment (due by Saturday 7 May and Friday 24 June)
